## Student award of the Ladies Night for Women in Engineering Sciences for young researchers

### Who can participate?

All female students from the engineering sector of MINT (faculties FVST, FMB, FIN, FEIT, FMA, FMATH, FNAT).

### What do I have to do?

Prepare a scientific poster about your research (bachelor or master thesis, Hiwi, Internship or proposal for future projects) until **April 3, 2020**. The poster must comprehensively explain the contents of the research to a jury of non-experts. Review of the posters will specifically focus on how the relevance of this work for future scientific or technical use is presented for the general public. All posters that fulfil the guidelines will be printed in size A0 and presented in an exhibition at the **Ladies Night** on **April 23rd, 2020** in the foyer of the **Max-Planck-Institute Magdeburg**. From these posters, three are selected by a jury. The winners, that are announced during the **Ladies Night**, will receive a certificate from the University as well as their printed posters. They will be offered the possibility to present their research during the Ladies Night.
